

The award-winning papers will be announced to EMS members soon, and the OPA winners will receive their awards at the EMS Extension, 17th Multinational Congress on Microscopy (17MCM), to be held on 07 to 12 September 2025 at Portorož, Slovenia. The application for EMS Scholarships to support young researchers for their participation in the EMS extension, 17th Multinational Congress on Microscopy (17MCM) is now closed, the deadline was March 14th, 2025. EMS received many applications and was able to provide 25 scholarships of 400 € each for the participation of early-stage career researchers at this conference.
